1. Condition of eligibility:- In order of to be eligible to compete at the examination, a candidate must satisfy the following conditions, namely:-

(i) **Nationality:-** The candidate must be a citizen of India.

(ii) Age :-

(a) A candidate must have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of 30 years on the first day of August, 2013.

(b) The upper age limit prescribed above will be relaxable :-

(i) up to a maximum of 5 years if a candidate belongs to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe;

(ii) 3 years in the case of candidates belongs to Other Backward Classes who are eligible to avail of reservation applicable to such candidates;

(iii) upto a maximum of 5 years in respect of trained Rangers of the Forest Department;

(iv) upto a maximum of 10 years in the case of blind, deaf-mute and Orthopedically handicapped persons.

2. **Essential Qualifications:-**The candidate must possess a Bachelor's Degree with at least one of the subjects, namely- Agriculture, Botany, Chemistry, Computer Application / Science, Engineering (Agricultural / Chemical / Civil / Computer / Electrical / Electronics / Mechanical), Environmental Science, Forestry, Geology, Horticulture, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics, Veterinary Science, Zoology of any University, deemed University or foreign University approved / recognised by the Central Government.

3. **Physical Standard-** The candidate must have the following physical standards in minimum :-

4. Candidates shall be required to appear at an open competitive examination and interview to be conducted by the Commission.

**(A) Written Examination:-**

**(i) Compulsory Subjects: (100 Marks each).**

- (1) General Knowledge
- (2) English (Essay & précis writing etc.)

**(ii) Optional Subjects:- (200 Marks each)**

**Any two subjects of the following Subjects:-**

- (i) Agriculture
- (ii) Botany
- (iii) Chemistry
- (iv) Computer Application/Science
- (v) Engineering (Agricultural / Chemical /Civil /Computer /Electrical / Electronics/ Mechanical)
- (vi) Environmental Science
- (vii) Forestry
- (viii) Geology
- (ix) Horticulture
- (x) Mathematics
- (xi) Physics
- (xii) Statistics
- (xiii) Veterinary Science
- (xiv) Zoology.

**Note:-**

- (1) The standard of these subjects shall be that of a Bachelor's Degree.
  - (2) The Candidates will not be allowed to offer the following combination of subjects:-
    - (i) Agriculture, Agricultural Engineering and Veterinary Science;
    - (ii) Chemical Engineering and Chemistry;
    - (iii) Computer Application / Science and Computer Engineering;
    - (iv) Electrical Engineering and Electronic Engineering;
    - (V) Mathematics and Statistics;
5. **Interview :-** The Commission shall conduct an interview for the candidates who qualifies in the written examination. The maximum marks shall be 75.


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6. **Medical Examination-** The medical examination shall be conducted by a duly constituted Medical Board including radiographic examination.

**Visual acuity:-** The examination for determining the acuteness of visions includes who tests – one for distant and the other for near vision. Each eye shall be tested separately. The following standard are prescribed for distant and near vision with or without glasses.

10. 3 (three) copies of candidate's recent passport size photograph along with the required educational certificates from Matriculation onwards which is to be authenticated by the candidate himself along with self addressed stamped of Rs. 5/- (size 27cm x 12 cm) and postage stamp of Rs. 5/- for Acknowledgement Card affixed thereon, should be submitted along with the application by the candidate. The candidates may also submit additional documents at the time of interview.
