No. 7/16/2014-MPSC (DR): In continuation to this Commission Notification of even No. dated 15-11-2014, the selection process for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor in Government Colleges will be as follows:-

Selection Process: - Educational Qualification shall carry 85 marks and Interview 15 marks. The distribution of marks for Academic and Interview has been given below:-

However, candidates will be given the benefit of Ph.D. Conversion of Grade Points to Percentage Equivalent will be carried out as per the Conversion Formula laid down by the University concerned. However, where the Universities have not laid down the Conversion Formula the determination of marks for the academic merit and Weightage shall be established on the basis of schedule I to IV. The merit list will be prepared in order of preference furnished by the candidate and on the basis of vacancies and reservation roster. In the event of total marks obtained from educational qualifications and interview being the same, candidates having higher marks in educational qualification will be placed higher in the final merit list. In the event of candidate having same educational qualification marks, candidates who are elder in age according to the date of birth will be placed higher in the final merit list and in the event of candidates having same date of birth, candidates whose name appear alphabetically first in Devnagiri Script will be placed higher in the final merit list.
