Sanjay Kumar (C.J.):

Ms. G. Pushpa, learned counsel, appears for the applicants. Mr. Lenin Hijam, learned Advocate General, Manipur, appears for the State. Mr. M. Rarry, learned counsel, appears for the Manipur Public Service Commission (MPSC).

By way of this miscellaneous case, the petitioners in W.P. (C) No. 312 of 2022 seek a direction to the MPSC not to declare the result of the Main Examination conducted by it from 26.05.2022 to 11.06.2022. It may be noted that this examination was conducted by the MPSC pursuant to the order dated 11.02.2022 passed by the Supreme Court in Special Leave Petition (Civil) Diary No. 5680 of 2021. Thereby, the Supreme Court specifically directed the MPSC to conduct the said examination afresh and not later than 4 months from that day. That would mean that the entire examination process, including declaration of the results, should be completed within that span of time.

In the light of the time stipulation fixed by the Supreme Court, it would not be proper for this Court to entertain any plea to restrain the MPSC from declaring the result of the examination.

MC [W.P. (C)] No. 235 of 2022 is accordingly dismissed on this short ground.
