IN PURSUANCE OF THE HON'BLE GAUHATI HIGH COURT, IMPHAL BENCH  
ORDER DATED 19.11.98 PASSED IN CIVIL ORIGINAL (CONTEMPT) CASE  
144 OF 1998 AND 145 OF 1997, APPLICATIONS ARE INVITED FOR  
THE FOLLOWING POSTS:

1. EDUCATION DEPARTMENT:

- i) Lecturers in Government Colleges (Except Law College, P.G.T. (D.M.C. of Teachers Education), HTI College, Lecturer in Computer Science and Lecturer in Electronics). (Temporary, Class-I), 109 posts (General-75, ST-32 and SC-2).

Subjectwise posts:- (1) Physics-5 (Gen-2, ST-2, SC-1), (2) Chemistry-5 (Gen-3, ST-2), (3) Bio-Chemistry-1 (Gen-3, ST-1), (4) Botany-6 (Gen-4, ST-2), (5) Zoology-4 (Gen-3, ST-1), (6) Anthropology-2, (7) Statistics-2, (8) Mathematics-3 (Gen-4, ST-1), (9) Geography-7 (Gen-5, ST-2), (10) Economics-9 (Gen-7, ST-2), (11) History-8 (Gen-5, ST-3), (12) Education-9 (Gen-6, ST-3), (13) Sociology-2 (Gen-1, ST-1), (14) Commerce-1, (15) Political Science-17 (Gen-11, ST-6), (16) Philosophy-6 (Gen-4, ST-2), (17) Manipuri-2 (Gen-1, ST-1), (18) Environmental Science-1, (19) English-13 (Gen-9, ST-4), (20) Hindi-3 and (21) Mizo-1.

Scale of pay:- Rs. 2200-4000/- with usual allowances.

Essential Qualifications:-

- (1) At least 55% marks at Post Graduate level.  
(2) Passed Accredited State Level Eligibility Test (to be conducted by the M.P.S.C.)

OR

Passed National Eligibility Test/JRF conducted by UGC/CSIR.

Note: "Candidates who had submitted their Ph.D. Thesis upto 31.12.93 and candidates who have done M.Phil upto 30.12.92 had been exempted from passing Accredited State Level National Eligibility Test.

OR

Passed National Eligibility Test/JRF conducted by UGC/CSIR (Qualification relaxable at the discretion of the Commission in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified).

- ii) Lecturer in Electronics (Govt. Colleges) (Temporary, Class-I), 1 (one) post (SC)

Scale of pay: Rs. 2200-4000/- with usual allowances.

Essential Qualifications:

- (1) Post Graduate Degree in Electronics (M.Tech./M.E./M.Sc.) with at least 55% marks or its equivalent from a recognised University.  
(2) At least Second Class Honours or at least 40% marks in aggregate for two years Degree Examination or 45% marks in aggregate for three years Degree Examination from a recognised University or its equivalent.

Failing which; (1) Post Graduate Degree(M.Sc.) in Physics with Electronics as a special subject/paper with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade from a recognised University. (2) At least Second Class Honours or at least 40% marks in aggregate for two years Degree examination or 45% marks in aggregate for three years Degree examination from a recognised University or its equivalent.

- (iii) Lecturer in Computer Science(Govt.Colleges) (Temporary Class-I)  
2(two) Posts ST.

Scale of pay:- Rs.2200-4000/-with usual allowances.

Essential Qualifications:

(1) Master's Degree in Computer Science/Application(MCA-2 years Post Graduate Course) or an equivalent Degree with at least 55% marks or its equivalent Degree from a recognised University. (2) At least Second Class Honours or at least 40% marks in aggregate for two years Degree Examination from a recognised University or its equivalent.

Failing which (1) Master Degree in Physics/Electronics/Statistics with one year Diploma in Computer Science from a recognised University with 2 years experience in Computer Science, development Computer programming and in core programme in Computer Science.

(2) At least Second Class honours or at least 40% marks in aggregate for two years Degree Examination or 45% marks in aggregate for three years Degree Examination from a recognised University or its equivalent.

- (iv) Lecturer, D.M.College of Teacher Education(Temporary, Class-I),  
3(three) posts/(Lecturer in General Science(Physics-1,  
Lecturer in History Method-1 and Lecturer in English  
Method-1).

Scale of pay: Rs.2200-4000/-with usual allowances.

Essential Qualifications:- (1) A consistently good academic record with a first or high second class at least 50% marks at Master's Degree examination with honours or distinction at the Degree stage in any subject taught in the College as method subject. (2) At least first or second Class B.T. Degree(Qualification relaxable at the discretion of the Commission in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified).

EXPLANATION : A consistently good academic record will be interpreted as an average of 50-55% marks at the two examinations preceeding the Master's Degree Examination.

Note:-The candidates who had already applied in response to MPSC's Advt.No.8/97-98 dated 24th February,1998 need not apply in the prescribed form again if they are eligible under the qualifications laid down above. They should however, submit an application in plain paper to the Commission indicating name, address and subject in which he/she was a candidate for the post. If no application is received within the time limit the application already applied for will not be considered.

N.B. :(1) See details in the Information for candidates attached in the application form.

(2) The posts may be increased or decreased according to actual requirement.

(3) Closing date for issue/receipt of application form and determining age will be 11.12.1998

- 4) Age : 35 years and below (Upper age limit is relaxable for Government servants appointed under the Government of Manipur to the extent of the ~~approximate~~ period of continuous service put in the post/Service by 3 years in respect of OBC candidates and by 5 years for SC/ST candidates and a Government servant who belongs to SC/ST/OBC will get the facility admissible to a Govt. servant in addition to the relaxation admissible to SC/ST/OBC candidates). (The upper age limit is further relaxable by 4 years vide D.P.'s Notification No.14/6/95-DP dated 1-6-1996). Further in ~~xxxxx~~ pursuance of the order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 1-8-1998 in C.R.No.370/97 and other 11 C.R. age bar in respect of any or some of the ~~xxxxxxx~~ past time Lecturer who have been engaged on payment of remuneration and who fulfil the essential qualifications shall be relaxed.
- 5) The prescribed essential qualifications, are minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle a candidate to be called for interview or short listing/Screening test. Where the number of application received in response to the notification is large and it will not be convenient or possible for the Commission to interview all those candidates, the Commission may restrict the number of candidates for interview to a reasonable limit of the basis of qualification and experience higher than the minimum prescribed in the notification or by holding a Screening test.
- 6) Application Fee of Rs.20/- for General and Rs.5/- for SC/ST candidates to be deposited in a Government Treasury in Manipur by Treasury Challan under Sub-Head 0051-public Service Commission, 01-Examination payable to the Secretary, Manipur public Service Commission, Imphel.
- 7) The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility or otherwise of the candidates will be final.
- 8) Loss/delay due to postal service will not be the responsibility of the Commission and no claim of such matter will be entertained.
- 9) Three copies of candidates recent passport size photograph along with the required certificate from Metriculation onwards to be authenticated by the candidates along with self addressed Stamped envelope of Rs.2/-(size 27cm x 12cm) and postage Stamp of Re.1/- for Acknowledgement Card affixed thereon should be submitted with the application by the candidate.

The prescribed application forms is obtainable on cash payment of Rs.5/- at the Commission's Counter or by remitting Money order to the Secretary, Manipur public Service Commission, Imphel-795001 with Self addressed Stamped envelope of 27cm x 12cm size.
